An award-winning, 295-room headquarters hotel connects to the Hampton Roads Convention Center by covered walkway. Plus, there are more than 2,500 hotel rooms within close proximity. The center also shares its campus with Hampton Coliseum, the 84,000-square-foot iconic arena that has long been a Coastal Virginia landmark. Also located minutes away, the Boo Williams Sportsplex is host to indoor

amateur athletic competitions. All venues are in convenient proximity to the exceptional shopping, dining, and entertainment in Peninsula Town Center, downtown Hampton, and the Phoebus Historic District.
